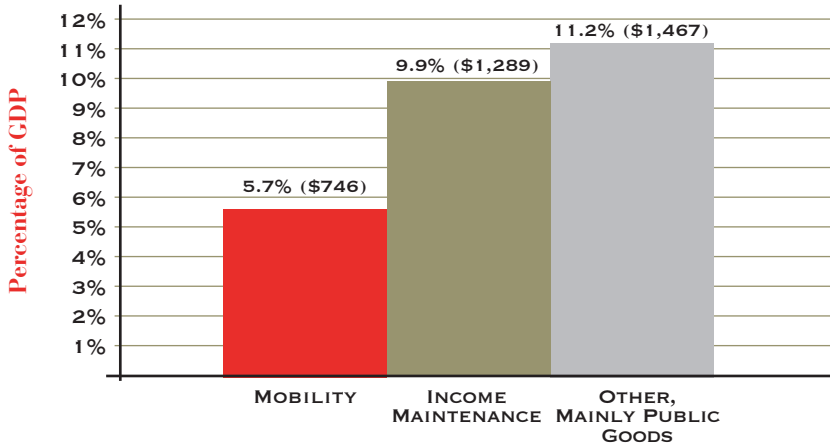


## How Much Does the Federal Government Spend to Promote Economic Mobility and for Whom?
